Du'a after Adhan

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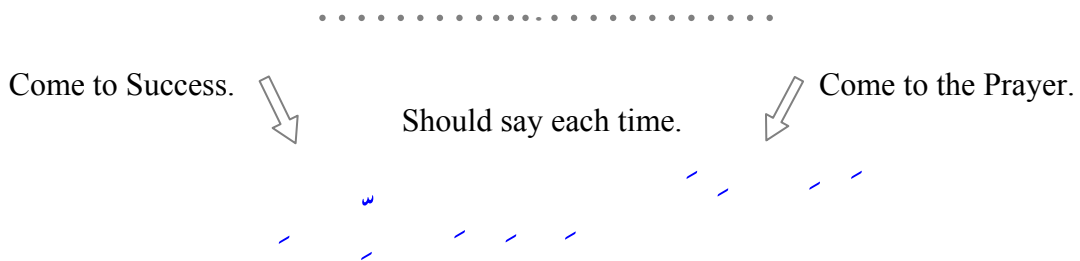

Surely You do not go back on Your promise. Have Mercy on us, for You are the Most Compassionate, the Most Merciful! "

Ijaabat (Answering)

Repeating the words of Adhan and Iqaamah is called Ijaabat.

Ijaabat for both Adhan and Iqaamah is Mustahab. Ijaabat means that those hearing should repeat the words of Adhan or Iqaamah as the Mu'azzin or Mukabbir says.

Iqaamah (call to start Pray)

"Mukabbir" stands up and calls out aloud repeat the wordings of Adhan at the beginning of Fardh Pray. Iqaamah (Takbeer) is called out in a comparatively softer voice. In Iqaamah after saying **Hay-ya 'A-lal Fa-lah**, you should add the words **Qad-qaa-matis-sa-lah** (twice).

When the times for Salah (Pray) come the Mukabbir stands up and call out Iqaamah these words:

Say Twice	Allah ﷻ is the greatest of all. Allah ﷻ is the greatest of all.
Twice	I bear witness that there is none Worthy of worship but Allah ﷻ.
Twice	I bear witness that Muhammad ﷺ is the Messenger of Allah ﷻ.
Twice	Come to the Prayer.

Twice	Allah ﷻ is the greatest of all.
One time	There is none worthy of worship but Allah ﷻ.

- Adhan and Iqaamah are Sunnah for men only.
- Adhan is Sunnah, but as it reveals a special glory of Islam, much stress is laid on it.
- Iqaamah is Sunnah for Fardh Salah (obligatory Pray) only. It is not Sunnah for any other Pray.
- Hazrat Abu Hurayrah ؓ narrates Rasulullah ﷺ said; "When the Iqaamah has been said, then there is no Salah valid (Nafil or Sunnah) except the Fardh Salah (obligatory Pray) for which the Iqaamah was said." (Ahmad, Muslim)
