

Allah ﷻ words used in conversation

The entire religion of Islam is based on the idea of getting closer to Allah ﷻ. So there is an emphasis in Islamic tradition to begin everything with Allah's name by using the Arabic phrase "Bismillah" which means "In the name of Allah ﷻ". Muslims when referring to the name of Allah ﷻ often add the words "Subhaa-nahu Wa-Ta'ala" after it meaning "The Exalted and the Great" as a sign of reverence.

Muslims also tend to use many other phrases in their daily lives that contain the word Allah ﷻ the following list of Arabic words used normally in conversations:

When you see or hearing good or bad:

"Allahu Akbar" ﷻ أَكْبَرُ ط

"Allah ﷻ is the Greatest"

Beginning of anything:

"Bismillah" ﷻ بِسْمِ اللَّهِ ط

"In the Name of Allah ﷻ"

When intending to do something:

"Insha Allah" ﷻ إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ ط

"If Allah ﷻ wills"

When you see calamitous:

"Ya Allah" ﷻ يَا اللَّهُ ط

"Oh Allah ﷻ"

For praising something:

Subhan-allah" ﷻ سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ ط

"Glory be to Allah ﷻ"

For expressing appreciation of something good:

"Masha-Allah" ﷻ مَا شَاءَ اللَّهُ ط

"Just as Allah ﷻ willed"

For showing gratitude to Allah after success or even after completing anything:

"Allhamdu lillah" ﷻ الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ ط

"All praise be to Allah ﷻ"

For expression of thanks someone:

"Jazakallahu khayran" ﷻ جَزَاكَ اللَّهُ خَيْرًا ط

"May Allah ﷻ reward you well with goodness"

**Responding to someone thanks/
a way of expressing thanks:**

"Barakallahu feekum" ﷻ بَارَكَ اللَّهُ فِيكُمْ ط

"May Allah ﷻ bless you all."

When an evil thought comes to mind:

"A'oozu-billah" ﷻ أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ ط

"I seek protection with Allah ﷻ"

**When abstains from doing wrong,
even when talking to another:**

"Astaghfirullah" ﷻ أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ ط

"I seek forgiveness of Allah ﷻ"
