

## Salawaat reading on Friday

اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ النَّبِيِّ الْأُمِّيِّ وَعَلَى آلِهِ وَسَلِّمْ تَسْلِيمًا ط

"Our Lord! Send salutations upon Muhammad ﷺ, the untaught Prophet, upon his family and send (continuous) peace." (Jame Sageer)

Narrated by Hazrat Abu Hurayrah ؓ that Rasulullah ﷺ said: "Whoever on a Friday (after Asr Salah), before rising from his place, recites Salawaat 80 times will have 80 years (worth) of his sins forgiven, and 80 years (worth) of good deeds are recorded for him."

## When tires Seventy angel writers for a thousand days

Hazrat Ibn Abbas ؓ narrates that Prophet ﷺ said; "whoever recites the following, tires seventy angel writers for a thousand days."

جَزَى اللَّهُ عَنَّا مُحَمَّدًا بِمَا هُوَ أَهْلُهُ ط

"Allah ﷻ reward Muhammad ﷺ on our behalf as he deserves." (At-Tabrani)

## Du'a for protection on the Day of Judgement (Qiyaamah)

Hazrat Thuban ؓ narrated that Prophet ﷺ said: "If a Muslim servant recites (the underlying) 3 times every morning, then it becomes the responsibility of Allah ﷻ to satisfy him on the Day of Judgement."

رَضِيتُ بِاللَّهِ رَبًّا وَبِالْإِسْلَامِ دِينًا وَبِمُحَمَّدٍ (صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) نَبِيًّا ط

"I am happy with Allah ﷻ as my lord, with Islam as my religion and Muhammad ﷺ as my Prophet." (Tirmidhi, Hisne-Haseen)
