

Taraweeh Prayer ﴿الصَّلَاةُ التَّرَاوِيحُ﴾

Taraweeh Salah, being Sunnah Muakkadah, is performed in al-Jama'at is "**Sunnah Kifaayah**" for man during the month of Ramadhan. It is offered at the time of the Isha Salah, after the completing the Prayers of 4 Fardh, 2 Sunnah and 2 Nafil, but before the Witr. During the Taraweeh Salah, it is the intention of the Imam/Qur'an Hafiz/Qari to complete the recitation of the Holy Qur'an over 27 or 28 days month of Ramadhan.

Remember that if you miss the 4 Fardh of Isha Salah you cannot start the Taraweeh Prayer. You would have to Pray the 4 Fardh Salah alone or Pray in al-Jama'at with some other person at a place separate from where the Taraweeh al-Jama'at is being performed. Also note that month of Ramadhan the Witr Salah is offered in al-Jama'at.

How to perform the Taraweeh Salah:

The Taraweeh Salah consists of 20 Raka'at and it is offered in 2 Raka'at and Prayed just like the 2 Raka'at of Sunnah or Nafil Prayer. After every 4 Raka'at Imam and Muqtadee (followers) take a short rest in between the Taraweeh Prayer and recite the Tasbeeh Taraweeh.

Tasbeeh of Taraweeh:

Tasbeeh Taraweeh should be learnt and memorised. Usually in many Masajids displayed Tasbeeh Taraweeh chart on the wall for the benefit of those who do not know the Tasbeeh. Tasbeeh of Taraweeh as follow:

﴿اللَّهُمَّ اجِرْنَا مِنَ النَّارِ ط﴾

﴿يَا مُجِيرُ ، يَا مُجِيرُ ، يَا مُجِيرُ ط﴾
